

Hello Honduras supporters!



We have safely returned from our trip, and wanted to share a little bit of information about the experience we had this year



First of all we wanted to thank you for your support of this amazing experience. Without your generosity, this trip would not be possible. We truly appreciate everyone who played a part in the successes that we experienced on this trip. Through your generosity, we were able to provide record amounts of care to the people of Cofradia, and specifically serve the children and families of Republica De Venezuela. Without your support, this trip would not have had the same impact, and we thank you for serving God's church, both local and international.

During this trip, we had six main focal points of service:

- Medical Care
- Dentistry
- Vacation Bible Study
- Construction
- Hair Cutting
- Clothing Distribution

Our medical and dental team was able to see 820 patients during the 5 days that they were serving, and provided a vast variety of care ranging from immunodeficiency treatment to wound care, and our dental team was able to teach the kids about proper hygiene and provide care where needed. They were also responsible for keeping our other teams in top shape, and we are incredibly thankful for their dedicated service to the mission



The hair salon was able to give 300+ haircuts in one week, which is a new record number. They were also able to take a moment to pray with the children and spend some time talking with them.



In our vacation bible school, the teachers taught 15 sessions over the course of 5 days, which shared the gospel of christ with over ___ students and children from the area.



In our clothing distribution, we were able to give out approximately 1250 lbs of clothes to people of various villages.



Our construction team was able to lay somewhere around 1500 concrete blocks, and finish the wall construction on a brand new school building. This building would house 3 more grades of high school, allowing the children of the school to get an additional 3 years of schooling.



One other ministry that we participated in was visiting and serving the children at Casa Hogar. For those of you who may not know, Casa Hogar is an orphanage in Honduras who we partner with to provide clothing and aid to. We were able to clothe all 31 children and spend some time talking and getting to know their stories. These children were so full of joy and excitement to get the donations that were provided and specially picked out by those families who supported them. Thank you especially to those families who sacrifice their time and their money to serve these children, because your donations to these children are so very special.
